

ABVLM Privacy Policy & Terms of Service

Introduction

This Privacy Policy, together with our Terms of Use, governs our applications, various websites (including www.abvlm.org), widgets, email notifications, and other mediums, or portions of such mediums (collectively, our “Services”), through which you have accessed this Privacy Policy.
